



## RESTROOM DISINFECTION

Restrooms can be a hub for infectious diseases and viruses. They consist of a couple different types of surfaces needing disinfection. Restroom surfaces can range anywhere from hard surfaces, to toilet bowls and urinals. With the global outbreak of COVID-19, it is more important than ever to regularly and properly disinfect your restroom surfaces.

While disinfecting, it is extremely important to use the necessary personal protective equipment (PPE) for all of these products. All disinfectants require the use of gloves and safety glasses

Examples of hard surfaces needing disinfecting in restrooms:

- Countertops
- Sinks
- Doorknobs
- Light switches

Examples of other surfaces needing disinfection in restrooms

- Toilet bowls
- Urinals



### Ecolution® Disinfectant (US only, excluding California)

- Proper PPE while using Ecolution Disinfectant is gloves and safety glasses
- Add 2 ounces of the concentrated product to the toilet bowl or urinal and mix
- Brush the water and disinfectant mixture thoroughly over exposed surfaces and under the rim
- Allow to stand and remain visibly wet for 10 minutes
- Flush



### F-362™ No Rinse (California and Canada only)

- Proper PPE while using F-362 No Rinse is gloves and safety glasses
- Add 2 ounces of the concentrated product to the toilet bowl or urinal and mix
- Brush the water and disinfectant mixture thoroughly over exposed surfaces and under the rim
- Allow to stand and remain visibly wet for 10 minutes
- Flush



### NDC™

- Proper PPE while using NDC is gloves and safety glasses
- Add 2 ounces of the concentrated product to the toilet bowl or urinal and mix
- Brush the water and disinfectant mixture thoroughly over exposed surfaces and under the rim
- Allow to stand and remain visibly wet for 10 minutes
- Flush
